



## **Fragile Presence / Action Space**

There is much in motion in society and, above all, there is a need for counter-movement to rampant nationalist and racist attitude. Solidarity and social cohesion are the order of the day - to counter the individualisation and inhumanity imposed by the economic system and politics. Rena Raedle and Vladan Jeremic have built three sculptures for the room, each composed of several objects. With a few simple steps that were previously unrecognisable are suddenly distributed round the room and can be arranged as furniture.

This room is available for groups to hold meetings, workshops, lessons, preparation of manifestations, etc. At the end of the activities, the original sculptures are reassembled. Between disassembling and reassembling, this work invites a new understanding of spatiality and, at the same time, it is open up new perspectives in terms of content.
